You or your organization has given to The MWV Children's Museum in the past. THANK YOU.

The MWV Children's Museum just purchased an exhibit that when all costs are factored, will be a \$20,000 exhibit teaching about emotional health. It is called I FEEL. We purchased it from the Children's Museum of Cleveland. We got grant funding for \$18,000 related to purchasing the exhibit (\$12,000 from Ham and \$6,000 from Zebs. THANK YOU). We did not factor in the cost for visitors to enjoy the exhibit. Operational support is often that hidden cost.

We are asking for help so that we can take full advantage of this beautiful opportunity. We want to help to work with parents on promoting the emotional health of tomorrow's adults. We seek to set up special events, guest speakers, hands on learning opportunities and group nights. This is an additional cost. We are asking for sponsors. Sponsoring a room means that a sign that has your business name will be on the wall of one of the rooms that house the exhibit. There are 5 rooms. It is that large. The size of the sign will be 5 x 7 for a \$500 donation. For an 8 x 10 sign it is a donation of \$1,000. We have over 2,100 families that are members and thousands of visitors play here every year.

Larger contributions and partnerships/collaborations are very welcome and can be discussed. This is an opportunity to teach empathy, management of anger, getting beyond fear and sadness to the first and foremost educators of young children; their parents. They will play with the exhibit while their parents participate in meaningful learning opportunities at our children's museum. Please contact us!

The grand opening will be in June of 2020. Sneak peak showings for specific rooms to test out lesson plans and speakers is happening now. The sooner we get sponsors, the sooner we can get our line-up finalized and be ready for the summer of 2020.
